2 FOLD IT

Press and fold shirts like a dry cleaner with fold-it organizers, most of which come with a folding board and instructions.

3 COMPRESS IT

Compression bags save space by squishing the air out a one-way vent. One manufacturer claims these bags give you up to 80 percent more space, but you may get less. Take an extra along so you can keep your dirty socks away from your last clean blouse. Another bonus: The clothes inside will stay dry, even if your bag gets stuck in a rainstorm on the runway. Just don't pack easily wrinkled fabrics this way.
