Some cold-weather comforts

Getting out and about in winter weather can be more fun, and toasty, with the following new products, all of which have been tested by the writer.



4. All fired up: A campfire in a metal fire pit is just the thing to take the chill off — and maybe toast some marshmallows. Now you can tote one along for cold-weather car camping or on tail-gate parties. The Corral 26-inch Copper Folding Fire Pit has collapsible legs, a removable cover screen to contain flying embers, and a lifting tool for safely handling the hot screen. Everything fits neatly into the included canvas zippered carry case, which has built-in handles. When you're ready to light your fire, just add some wood, and maybe some fire-starter chips, and light 'er up. Sparks can still escape, so not for use in windy weather.
